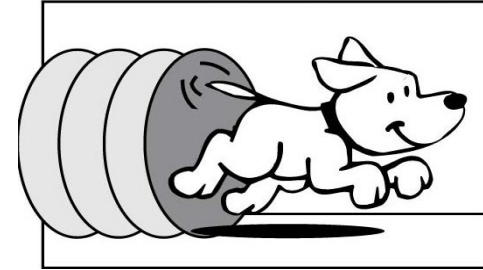

**MOVE UP REGULATIONS**

Dogs shall be moved up to a higher class at the request of the owner, as a result of qualifying for an agility title, **provided that the request is made to the Trial Secretary, in writing, no later than 6:00 PM, Monday, Sept 20, 2010.**

DAY TO DAY MOVE-UPS will be accepted for Saturday and Sunday until immediately following the awarding of ribbons for the last class on the previous day.

**AKC AGILITY "MOVE-UP" FORM**

This form **MUST** be filled out completely - **NO VERBAL CHANGES WILL BE ACCEPTED.** E-mail move-ups will be accepted but must include all required information.

Fill out one form for each dog and mail, e-mail, or hand deliver to the TRIAL SECRETARY - **NO ONE ELSE IS AUTHORIZED TO ACCEPT MOVE-UPS.**

**Note:** Changes from Regular to Preferred or vice versa, changes from Novice A to Novice B, and changes in jump height after closing do **not** constitute a valid move up and are **not** permitted after closing. A dog may change jump height after closing only as the result of being measured into a higher height division at these trials, or receiving a height card measurement for the higher height after the closing date. A Novice A dog earning an agility title after the closing date is still eligible to run in Novice A for these trials. The move-up form may be used for Novice A to Novice B changes **before** closing only.

## ATTENTION EXHIBITORS

The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport and of AKC and that their dogs are familiar with and are able to perform all obstacles safely. Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations. Proof of current vaccinations, including rabies, must be available at the trial if requested.

All dogs must be held on leash or crated at all times except when in the ring or in the designated agility warm up area. **Dogs are not permitted on the outdoor soccer fields and must be exercised in marked areas only.**

Dogs are not required to be at the trial until the scheduled time of judging. Exhibitors are responsible for being at ringside when it is their turn to run. Judges need not wait for dogs who are holding up the class.

An exercise area will be provided. All handlers must pick up after their dogs. **Anyone not cleaning up after their dogs or exercising their dogs in prohibited areas will be asked to leave.** In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

WI-IL Agility Club assumes NO responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. Owners/handlers enter at their own risk and agree to assume responsibility for any damage caused by them, their dogs, or their children.

The club reserves the right to remove any animal in distress from a parked vehicle or crate, and all persons attending this agility trial hereby waive any claim for damages against the club for such removal.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from the competition by action of the Trial Committee, except that a refund of entry fees minus \$8/day, for bitches in season will be made (a signed statement from a veterinarian must be received by the Trial Secretary on or before the day of the trial before judging starts). No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

**CLASSES OFFERED:** Standard (Novice A & B, Open, Excellent A & B), Jumpers with Weaves (Novice A & B, Open, Excellent A & B), Standard Preferred (Novice, Open, Excellent A & B), Jumpers with Weaves Preferred (Novice, Open, Excellent A & B)

**CATALOGS:** Catalogs may be reserved for \$10 by checking the appropriate box on the entry form and including the catalog fee with your entry fees. A limited number will be available for purchase on the day of the trial. Running orders will be provided free to all exhibitors.

**OBSTACLES:** Obstacles will conform to the requirements in the current edition of the regulations for AKC Agility Trials.

**FOOD:** There is a concession stand operated by the sports facility.

**VENDORS:** If you wish to be a vendor at these trials, you must contact the vendor coordinator, e-mail Pam Kristoff at Rottzmom@yahoo.com (preferred) or call (847) 494-1661 to register as a vendor.

**CRATING:** Bring something to put under your crates to protect the floor. No ex-pens allowed unless they will be used to hold at least two big or three small dogs.

**ELECTRONIC TIMING:** Electronic timing will be used at these trials.

**LIMITED PARKING:** Parking is limited. Please carpool if possible.

**Each dog must be entered in ONLY Regular classes OR Preferred classes for the weekend. Each dog must be entered in only one height division for the weekend.**

## HEIGHT DIVISIONS

Owners are responsible for entering the proper height division as shown in the table below. Handlers may opt to run in a higher height division for regular classes ONLY, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in Preferred MUST run in their correct height division; they may not run at a higher or lower height. Dogs that run in a regular height division lower than their proper division or in a preferred height division at other than their proper division will be eliminated. **In no case may a dog be moved down in height after closing, whether due to an exhibitor entry error or due to a judge's measurement. Preferred dogs incorrectly entered in a higher height division will not be permitted to run and no entry fee will be refunded.** The secretary is not responsible for ensuring that a dog is entered in the proper height division. Any and all errors in height division entered are solely the responsibility of the exhibitor.

## DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds,, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. Refer to chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate. Mixed breed dogs that have been listed with AKC Canine Partners may participate provided their listing number has been recorded on the entry form.

## SIMPLIFIED HEIGHT CARD PROCESS

When filling out the entry form, there is a new section at the top of the form for exhibitors to designate whether your dog has a valid jump height card or if your dog needs to be measured. Please check the appropriate box so that the Trial Secretary knows whether to include your dog on the Dogs To Be Measured List. **It is no longer required that you submit a copy of your dog's jump height card with your entry form or show it during day of show check-in.**

## COURSE FAMILIARIZATION AND WARM-UPS

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of the class. A walk through period will be held prior to each class.

There will be no contact obstacle familiarization for novice dogs.

A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, shall be provided for all exhibitors. Exhibitors may not use the warm-up area to relieve their dogs. Consideration should be given to those teams who are due in the ring prior to other teams wishing to use the jump.

Umbrellas are not allowed on the course during the walk thru.

## PRIZES AND AWARDS

Dogs must qualify to receive awards. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score. Placement rosettes will be awarded for 1<sup>st</sup> through 4<sup>th</sup> place in each class in each height division. New title rosettes will be awarded to dogs completing an agility title at these trials (special title rosettes will be awarded for new MX and MXJ titles). Double Q ribbons will be awarded to dogs qualifying in Excellent B Std & JWW (Regular) on the same day. A MACH/PAX rosette and bar will be awarded to dogs completing a MACH/PAX title at these trials. If your dog may earn a MACH/PAX at these trials, please notify the trial secretary on or before the morning of the trial. All prizes must be claimed at the trial, none will be mailed.

Online entries will **NOT** be accepted for these trials.

## DIRECTIONS TO TRIAL SITE

From ILLINOIS HWY 14 in Crystal Lake: GO NORTH on RIDGEFIELD RD. Regional Sports Center is on the west side of the road. Look for the large building with the Soccer Ball on it.

### From the North:

HWY 14 can be accessed from I-43 between Milwaukee and Rockford. Take HWY 14 EAST. You will pass through Darien, Harvard and Woodstock. Continue on HWY 14 to RIDGEFIELD RD. NORTH (turn Left), Regional Sports Center will be on the left side of the road.

### From the South/Chicago:

HWY 14 can be accessed from the South by taking I-90 WEST to RT 31 NORTH. Take RT 31 NORTH through Carpentersville and Algonquin to RT 176 WEST (turn Left) to RT 14 WEST (turn Right) and go 2.2 miles to RIDGEFIELD RD NORTH (turn Right), Regional Sports Center will be on the left side of the road.

Take the exit for 176 WEST. Follow 176 through Mundelein and Wauconda and past Route 31 to HWY 14 WEST (turn Right). Take HWY 14 approximately 2.2 miles to RIDGEFIELD RD NORTH (turn Right), Regional Sports Center will be on the left side of the road.

In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons. INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division. All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Mixed breed dogs enrolled in the AKC Canine Partners program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. Mixed breed dogs entered in these events must list the breed name as "Canine Partner" (mixed breed) and not as a breed hybrid and must include their AKC Canine Partners number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 816-3776. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?
