Food/snacks/beverages provided throughout the day.

Worker Trial Card – how it works:

- For each half hour your work in either ring, you will receive a worker ticket from the ring captains. Any other work outside of the rings you will receive worker tickets from the trial chair(s).
- Turn in your worker tickets to either the trial chair(s) or the food coordinator for punches on a worker trial card.
- Each worker ticket is worth one punch on the card.
- Each punch (half hour of work) is worth \$1 on the Worker Trial Card.
- The Worker Trial Card has 18 lines. A completed card is worth \$18 (9 hours of work).
- Cards may be used to pay for future trial entries. The number of punches on your card equals the number of dollars you may apply towards your entries. You do not have to wait to use a completed card. You may use a partial card but only for the amount of punches.
EXAMPLE: 5 punches on your card mean you have \$5 off to apply towards future entries.
- The cards must be submitted with your entry. You cannot turn them in later.
- Time will be rounded up to the nearest half hour (so a 46 minute class will be treated as an hour).
- Workers at any time may turn their worker tickets in to the Trial Chair in exchange for punches on their Worker Trial Card.
- Please write your name on the back of each card, because....
- Lost or stolen worker tickets or cards are not replaceable, so don't lose them.
